General Instructions

Use of this form is only permitted if the Director has approved a request to satisfy registration requirements by using a paper document in accordance with section 27.1 of Regulation 347.

This form may be used to satisfy requirements under section 84 of Regulation 347.

Please complete and submit the Land Disposal Registration Notification form (Part 2B) for each waste stream subject to Land Disposal Registration reporting and notification requirements.

By completing the questionnaire on the Waste Identification Form (Part 2A) for each hazardous waste stream, generators can determine if they need to complete the Land Disposal Restrictions Notification Form (Part 2B). Notification is a one-time requirement that provides the receiver with information about the waste and the relevant treatment requirement, and states whether the waste has been partially or fully treated. Each waste-generating facility that ships a waste stream that requires a Land Disposal Restrictions Notification Form (Part 2B) to be completed, must provide the receiving facility with the information contained in the most recent Land Disposal Restrictions Notification Form (Part 2B) of the Generator Registration Report. The notification must be done either before or on the first transfer of the waste.

It is important to note that you, as a waste generator, are responsible for the characterization of your wastes and for the information submitted. The Ministry will input information from your signed Land Disposal Restrictions Notification Form (Part 2B) into the Resource Productivity and Recovery Authority's (RPRA) Hazardous Waste Program Registry on your behalf, but it is your responsibility to ensure that the information entered is correct. If your waste is found to be incorrectly characterized or the information supplied on the Generator Registration Report is incorrect, you are liable for prosecution.
