## **Award Information**

The Lieutenant Governor's Community Volunteer Award for Students pays tribute to students who not only complete the required number of volunteer hours to graduate, but who go above and beyond.

Each year, an award is given to one graduating student at each of Ontario's secondary schools.

## Who is eligible?

The award is for students who live in Ontario and are graduating from an Ontario high school (public, provincial, private and demonstration).

## How are the recipients selected?

School principals, or their designate, select one student from their school and complete and submit the nomination form. A school committee dedicated to student recognition may also select the recipient. However, only the principal and/or his or her designate may complete and submit the form.
