

## June Callwood Outstanding Achievement Award

### **Award Information**

To recognize individuals and groups for superlative volunteer contributions and volunteer management in their communities and to the province of Ontario.

## Who is eligible?

## The award has two (2) categories:

## **Outstanding Volunteer Award**

Recognizes an individual or group for their commitment to volunteering and longstanding service to their community. Up to 20 individuals and/or groups receive this award each year.

## **Excellence in Volunteer Management Award**

Recognizes an individual or group from an organization that is incorporated as a not for-profit corporation or registered as a charity with Canada Revenue Agency for their achievement in identifying, strengthening, and maximizing volunteer involvement for the purpose of improving the quality of life of individuals and their communities. Up to five individuals and/or groups receive this award each year.

Your nominee must be:

- An individual or a group.
- · A resident of Ontario.
- · A living person or an existing institution.

Nominations will not be accepted if they are self-nominated or for elected federal, provincial, municipal representatives while in office or political appointees.

## How are the recipients selected?

An independent selection committee appointed by the Minister of Heritage, Sport, Tourism and Culture Industries reviews all nominations and recommends the candidates.

#### When are the awards presented?

The Minister presents the awards at a special recognition ceremony in Toronto.

## **Required Information**

- Nominee name and contact information (address, telephone number, email etc...)
  - If nominee is a group, provide a group contact
- A detailed description why your nominee should receive the award
- Two signed testimonial letters from two separate individuals who have direct knowledge of the value and impact of the nominee's achievement and who support the nomination. Digital signatures or a scanned copy of the signed letter are accepted
- Supporting documents (optional) such as supplementary testimonials, publications, media stories, etc.
