- Conduct and Duties of Police Officers Respecting Investigations by the Special Investigations Unit Regulation;
- Equipment and Use of Force Regulation;
- Code of Conduct under the General Regulation;
- Suspect Apprehension Pursuits Regulation.

Pursuant to the Equipment and Use of Force Regulation you may not use force on another person unless you have successfully completed a training course on the use of force.

Pursuant to the Equipment and Use of Force Regulation you may not carry a firearm unless you have successfully completed a training course on the use of firearms in the previous twelve months.
