Submissions must be received by 5:00 pm, May 30, 2025

General Information

You can nominate an adult learner who has transformed their life through achieving their goal of advancing their education and training by attaining high school or equivalent, entering an apprenticeship, or moving into post-secondary education. Nominees must:

- 1. Live in Ontario;
- 2. Have been actively involved in activities in Ontario relating to this year's award category in the last 12 months;
- 3. Provide their consent to be nominated, agree to accept the award at a presentation in an awards ceremony and sign a release and consent for promotional purposes.

Eligibility

To be eligible, your submission must include:

- 1. A completed and signed nomination form, which includes a summary of the nominee's achievements, outlining why they deserve to receive the award (maximum 500 words); **plus**
- 2. At least one letter of support (maximum 500 words each). Letters must be from someone other than the nominee who can provide firsthand insight into a nominee's activities related to this category.

Submission

Submissions must be made as a complete package. Please type your submission or print clearly. Entries will be assessed based on the substance of the submissions, not on quality of writing or grammar. **Please do not send photographs, books, CDs, DVDs or other additional materials.**

The recipient will be contacted by July 10th, 2025. The recipient must agree to accept the award at a presentation in an Ontario awards ceremony (date to be determined) and will be asked to sign a release and consent form for promotional purposes.
