(hereinafter the "offender") is an offender within the meaning of subsection 1(1) of the Act, who was resident in Ontario and who was therefore obligated to report as required by the Act to a designated bureau, police station or detachment of the police service where the offender resides or to another designated place in the area where the police service provides policing

(hereinafter a "registration location") on or before (Date Required to Register (yyyy/mm/dd)) _____,

and failed to do so in violation of the Act and that it is reasonable and necessary to arrest the offender pursuant to subsection 11(3) of the Act for the purpose of having the offender comply with their obligation.

This warrant authorizes any police officer to arrest the offender for the purpose of bringing the offender to a registration location for the purpose of complying with their reporting obligation under the Act.

The offender shall be released forthwith after being brought to a registration location pursuant to this warrant.

This warrant may be executed anywhere in Ontario and is valid until it is executed.
